



## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

### ISSUE 3

Power System Services recognises its Environmental Responsibilities towards its employees, customers, shareholders and the general public and adopts a pro-active policy with regard to Environmental Management.

The responsibility for Environmental matters resides with the Chief Executive at Corporate level and with the Location Manager at Operational level.

Environmental concerns are not considered as a separate entity but are incorporated into the well established and independently recognised quality and safety system.


Environmental policy will comply in general with the ISO 14000/14001 -"Specification for Environmental Management systems ".

This policy will ensure that :

1. As a minimum the Company and its Subcontractor complies with all the statutory requirements in relation to the country in which it operates.
2. That employees, visitors, members of the public (whether local or remote) are afforded protection against all emissions (Noise, Vibration, Radiation, Dust, Chemicals, etc.) and that wherever possible the cause of any hazard or emission is eliminated at source.
3. That environmental factors will be considered at the design stage of any process or product, will consider the full life - cycle of the process/product and that environmental costs will be carefully balanced against the interests of all stakeholders using optimised-total-cost principles.
4. That Environmental safeguards will be incorporated into Quality Plans, Safety Systems and Work Instructions.

This policy is an integral part of and carries the same authority as the Quality and Safety policies contained in the Corporate Manual.
